

Reminder - Treatment for chlamydia

Hello

You have previously received a letter advising you to seek treatment for your chlamydia infection. However, I can still not see that you have participated in contact tracing or received treatment for your infection. **Under the Communicable Diseases Act, you are required to cooperate with contact tracing.** All healthcare staff are bound by strict confidentiality, and all information disclosed during your visit is protected by medical confidentiality laws.

Please contact your nearest youth health clinic (up to age 24), midwifery clinic, or the Sexual Health Clinic to arrange contact tracing and treatment. Contact details can be found at www.1177.se/gavleborg/hitta-varld.

Chlamydia is a bacterial infection that is treated with antibiotics. If left untreated, chlamydia may cause infertility. Treatment is provided free of charge. Using a condom during sexual activity offers good protection against chlamydia. **You are required to inform and protect your sexual contacts until your treatment has been completed.**

Contact the Sexual Health Clinic as soon as possible!

If we have not heard from you within two weeks, your case will be referred to the Communicable Disease Control Physician, as you are legally required under the Communicable Diseases Act to cooperate with contact tracing.
