

Testing for Syphilis

Hello

I am writing to inform you that you need to be tested for syphilis. A person who has been treated for a syphilis infection has stated that you may have been exposed to the infection. There is a risk that you have an infection even if you do not have any symptoms.

Under the Communicable Diseases Act, you are required to undergo testing.

All healthcare staff are bound by strict confidentiality, and all information disclosed during your visit is protected by medical confidentiality laws.

Syphilis is a bacterial infection that is transmitted through sexual contact. It may cause a sore a few weeks after exposure to the infection. The sore may heal without treatment, but the bacteria remain in the body and you may not experience any symptoms. If left untreated, a syphilis infection can lead to serious damage to the heart or brain.

Syphilis is treated with antibiotics, and testing and any necessary treatment are provided free of charge.

Protect your sexual contacts until you have been tested and, if necessary, received treatment.

You need to have the test within 2 weeks, no later than
